Premiere Pro Bootcamp

Learn how to edit professional-quality videos using Adobe Premiere Pro. This course covers everything from importing footage to advanced editing techniques like multi-cam editing and green screen removal.

- Import, organize, and manage video and audio files within the Premiere Pro workspace.
- Edit video clips using trimming tools, ripple edits, and time remapping for smooth transitions.
- Enhance audio by cleaning background noise, syncing tracks, and adjusting levels.
- Create motion graphics, add lower-third titles, and incorporate animated effects.
- Apply color correction and grading using adjustment layers and built-in tools.
- Export and optimize video files for social media, clients, or broadcast-quality output.

Premiere Pro Advanced

Take your video editing skills to the next level with advanced techniques in Premiere Pro. This course covers custom transitions, visual effects, action editing, and vertical video production for social media.

After Effects Bootcamp

After Effects Compositing, Tracking, & Keying

- Use motion tracking with Point Tracker and MochaAE to match movement with precision.
- Remove backgrounds with green screen keying using the Keylight effect and garbage mattes.
- Stabilize shaky footage with the Warp Stabilizer VFX tool for smooth motion.
- Apply time remapping techniques to create slow-motion, fast-motion, and frame-blended effects.
- Rotoscope video footage using manual techniques and the Roto Brush tool.
- Work with track mattes to create complex layering effects with images and video.

After Effects Advanced

Take your motion graphics and animation skills to the next level with advanced techniques in Adobe After Effects. This course covers 3D layers, custom shape animations, expressions, and professional text effects.

- Work with 3D layers, cameras, and lights to create dynamic motion graphics.
- Create and animate custom shape layers using the Pen Tool and advanced shape effects.
- Develop complex text animations and save custom presets for future projects.
- Optimize animations using expressions to automate movement and link properties.
- Refine motion with the Graph Editor, Motion Sketch, and Smoother Panel.
- Enhance audio integration by adding markers, effects, and keyframe-based animations.

- Build supporting materials—including a project plan, moodboard, style frames, and storyboard—to guide your editing and animation process and align your work with a consistent visual style and tone.
- Produce an animatic to preview the pacing and structure of your final video, then bring your concept to life using Adobe Premiere Pro and Adobe After Effects to edit, animate, and composite a polished final piece.
- Work on your capstone project both in and outside of class, using scheduled mentoring sessions to review your progress, ask questions, and get personalized feedback from your instructor as you finalize your project for your professional portfolio.
